Support Coordinator Position Requirements

Community Living St. Catharines' Support Coordinators provide a wide range of supports to persons with an intellectual disability aged 18-years and older in the absence of natural family supports, friends, and community. This program provides 24-hour support staff within a group home setting.

Employment opportunities include permanent and temporary positions in the following capacity:

- Relief - 0-24 hours per week plus on-call
- Part-time - 0-29 hours per week
- Full-time - 40 hours per week
30 hours per week Overnight Asleep Shifts & up to 39 hours per week Overnight Awake Shifts

Responsibilities:

Actively provide direct care through assistance, guidance, and life skill coaching. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, personal and health care, goal planning, overall household duties, shopping, and meal preparation. Ensure the safety and well-being of each person at all times.

Requirement:

1. Completion of a two-year Community College Course and up to six months experience in a related field.
2. Completion of a one-year post-secondary course and up to one-year experience in a related field.
3. Valid "G" License
4. Police Check Clearance Certificate
5. First Aid, CPR Certification

Certification must be **valid prior** to the hire date. **ALL** employees are responsible for the completion of this requirement.

- Drivers Abstract
- Non-Violent Crisis Intervention
- Mandatory One day Quality & Leadership Session for new employees
